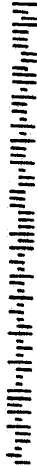

Iâ€™ve just posted a website related to my experience with a racketeering situation at Bank of America and industry wide collusion related to Home Equity Line of Credit Products. Governor Hogan was notified of the situation via UPS overnight mail this AM. Your copy of the letter and documents sent to him are posted for your review on the website below.

This is a big deal to me for both myself and my fellow citizens. This racket affects my monthly payment by \$1700/month, and thereâ€™s a chance i could loose my home due to this crap. And hereâ€™s the very important partâ€¦. approximately 66,000 other Marylanders may get caught in this same type of racket between 2014 and 2017. MD could experience \$300 million in reduced consumer spending each year for the next 2-4 years due to the banks cash-cull. MD can expect to see as many as 1320 foreclosures due to this racket alone.

After calling bullshit on Bank of America for the scam, I was offered a reduced payment as long as I signed a non-disclosure agreement, which I declined.

This is just too big of a deal to cover up. Bank of Americaâ€™s screw-ups are so blatant, and the industry wide collusion is so blatant, this is a no brainer to identify and shut down. Itâ€™s sitting in plain view. Iâ€™ve explained everything on the website and Iâ€™ve provided documentation and
